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## SAREES

The saree (also sari or shari) is the most representative traditional clothing of the Indian subcontinent. It consists of a drape that can be from 4.5 meters to 8 meters long, and about 1 meter wide. It is usually wrapped around the waist, with one end covering one shoulder and baring the midriff.

## PUNJABI

Salwar Kameez

The Salwar is the traditional dress of women in the Punjab region. It is made up of a kurta or kameez and a straight cut salwar. In some parts of the Punjab region, men also wear the Punjabi suit.

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# VASTHI

A Vi (Tamil: வி), also known as veshti, is a white unstitched cloth wrap for the lower body in Tamil Nadu and in the North and East of Sri Lanka (Tamil Eelam). Vi is a part of the traditional attire consisting of Kurta and Angvasutra. The garment is a single piece of cloth and similar to the dhoti, one of the earliest draped garments of India. A vi is often layered with horizontal stripes or borders across its length.

# Dhoti Kurta

It is a lower garment forming part of the ethnic costume for men in the Indian subcontinent. The dhoti is fashioned out of a rectangular piece of unstitched cloth, usually around 4.5 metres (15 ft) long, wrapped around the waist and the legs and knotted, either in the front or the back.
